

**Call for Papers
2021 Annual Meeting
(Virtual with Possible In-Person Component)**

Due to the uncertainty surrounding academic travel, the SRIA board has not yet decided on the format of the November 2021 annual meeting. If travel is possible, we will host a meeting at one of our partner universities. We do anticipate that travel might still be restricted for some members and as such there will be a virtual component to the conference. If travel is not possible, then the 2021 meeting will be entirely virtual. We anticipate holding the meeting sometime in late November. More details regarding the meeting will be forthcoming.

You are encouraged to submit a proposal to present original research findings at the SRIA 2021 Annual Meeting. Papers on any risk or insurance related topic are welcome. Specific subject areas include, but are not limited to, insurance law or regulation, public policy, economics, finance, health care, international issues, employee benefits, or risk management.

Please submit an executive summary (not exceeding three pages) that describes the purpose, expected results, and importance of the research (completed, full papers may also be submitted). The names and affiliations of all co-authors, with telephone number and e-mail address (if available) of the designated contact person, should be provided on a separate cover page attached to the proposal. Please also include three keywords on your executive summary to assist in the appropriate session placement of your paper.

Proposals/papers from doctoral students are encouraged. Please clearly label submissions from doctoral students. Doctoral students that have proposals/papers accepted for presentation at the meeting will be invited to submit a full paper for the “Harris Schlesinger Memorial Doctoral Research Award.”

The deadline for submission is Friday, August 13, 2021. This deadline will not be extended. Submitting authors will be notified of the outcome of their submissions via email within four weeks of the submission deadline.

In order to stay on the program, at least one author of the accepted paper must register for the meeting by no later than October 22, 2021. Additional information regarding the registration fees will be forthcoming.
